The overhead crane has been built to be utilizing performing repetitive hoisting activities. This particular kind of crane can be used in various capacities. They could be used for specialized lifting jobs like for example removing or installing major plant machinery.

Operators and worker need to employ safe rigging practices in order to safely operate an overhead crane. This will require both practice and knowledge since the load must be correctly rigged to ensure its stability when lifted. Prior to starting a lifting task, it should be determined that the crane is suitable for the job, with right travel, lift and capacity. The crane has to be subjected to a thorough visual and physical check before utilization. The capacity of all equipment, including the slings, hardware and rope, must never go beyond load weight capacities.

Before using the rigger has to know what sling is right for each lift and be able to check the rigging gear and hardware. The communications which are utilized with the crane operator need to be clear and concise. A signaler should be designated for the role and signals should be agreed upon. The operator of the crane should follow directions just from the designated person. If a wired or remote controller is being used, the operator should be trained in all its functions.

Before any lifting starts, the path of the load should be cleared of all obstructions and a warning sign must be issued to guarantee the safety of the employees. Pedestrian are not under any circumstance allowed to walk under the lift loads. The crane hoist should be centered over the load before lifting in order to prevent swinging. The safety catch should be closed immediately after sliding the sling fully onto the hoisting hook. Unused sling legs must be secured so they do not drag. Never leave loose materials on a load being hoisted. Watch that hands and fingers are clear when slack is taken out of a sling. Before the lift is carried out, step clear of the danger zone.
